Mission

EBOAI exists to build ethical, community-centered AI that protects truth, promotes equity, and ensures technology serves humanity. We create transparent systems, train civic leaders, and advance data integrity models that begin in Baltimore and scale globally.

Vision

To establish Baltimore as a national model for ethical AI innovation, where communities, creators, and institutions collaborate to make technology more inclusive, responsible, and trustworthy.

Advisory Commitment

We're inviting a select group of advisors to help shape the early direction of EBOAI's research, partnerships, and impact frameworks.

This is a light-lift commitment designed for leaders who want to contribute strategic insight and connectivity ***without operational burden.***

Structure

- **Quarterly “Brain Dump” Sessions:**
90-minute whiteboard-style discussions (virtual or in-person) focused on mapping strategic direction for our team to execute.
- **Network & Resource Sharing:**
Advisors share relationships, ideas, and opportunities that strengthen EBOAI's mission.
- **Collaborative Framework:**
Advisors contribute perspective; EBOAI leads execution.

Timeframe

- **Initial 6-month term:** Uncompensated, focused on shared alignment and early impact.
- **Post-6 months:** Opportunity to structure a consulting or compensated advisory agreement based on scope and nonprofit capacity.

We are **not assigning formal board seats** during this phase. Advisors participate as part of the **EBOAI Founding Advisory Collective**, supporting strategic design while the nonprofit's governance and operating framework are established.

Next Steps

Advisors may choose one of three **entry points**:

1. **Strategic Advisor:** Contribute expertise in AI, equity, and innovation strategy.
2. **Network Advisor:** Connect EBOAI to funders, partners, and civic collaborators.
3. **Impact Advisor:** Guide program design and community engagement frameworks.
